

In support of regional *"May is Bike Month,"* Sacramento County, El Dorado County and the Cities of Folsom and Rancho Cordova are closing portions of Scott Road, White Rock Road and Placerville Road for the 2014 Scott Road Bike and Walk Event. These closures will provide bicyclists and pedestrians with an opportunity to travel on stretches of road -- with no through motor vehicle traffic -- that have rolling hills and impressive views of the Sierra Nevada mountains. Event details are listed below, and a map is included on page 2 of this release.

- Date & Time: Sunday, May 4, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Locations: 1) Scott Road between the US-50/Scott Road Interchange and Latrobe Road; 2) portions of Placerville Road; 3) White Rock Road from Luyung Drive (near Sunrise Boulevard) to the Sacramento County/El Dorado County line. These sections of roadway will be closed to all through vehicles. Bicyclists can also ride on striped bicycle lanes on White Rock Road in El Dorado County to the Town Center near Latrobe Road.
- Access Locations, Parking and Detours: See the map for access locations, parking areas and detours.
- Light-Rail: Bicyclists can take Light-Rail to the Folsom Boulevard/Iron Point Road Station and cycle east on Iron Point Road to East Bidwell Street south or to the Placerville Road undercrossing to White Rock Road.
- Water: Attendees are advised to bring their own water.
