State Route 99 at Elverta Road Interchange Project ~Overnight Lane Shifts and Local Road Closures: 12/18 to 12/22~

Sacramento, CA – From Tuesday, December 18 to Saturday, December 22 from 7 P.M. to 5 A.M. nightly, there will be freeway lane shifts and local road closures that will affect the traveling public at the State Route 99 (SR 99) at Elverta Road Interchange. Details and locations are listed below:

1. Northbound and Southbound SR 99 at Elverta Road.

Northbound and southbound motorists will experience lane shifts and closures as SR 99 at Elverta Road freeway lanes are adjusted to accommodate the movement of concrete barriers needed to protect workers during construction of structural falsework. Motorists should expect delays.

2. Elverta Road East of SR 99.

Left turns will be prohibited at the intersection of Elverta Road and SR 99. Southbound SR 99 traffic will be detoured to Elkhorn Boulevard, and westbound Elverta Road traffic will be detoured along northbound SR 99 to Riego Road.

Note: A full closure of West Elverta Road from Metro Air Parkway to State Route 99 is already in effect as part of the interchange project. West Elverta Road is closed to all traffic until December 2013.

Interchange Construction: This project will construct a new interchange to replace the existing at-grade signalized intersection at this location. Major elements of the interchange project include:

- Construction of a new interchange with ramp meters and HOV by-pass lanes on all freeway on-ramps.
- Widening and reconstructing approximately 1 mile of Elverta Road.
- Addition of bicycle lanes and sidewalks.
- Relocation of existing drainage canals.
- Two new traffic signals at the terminus of the freeway off-ramps.
- Drought tolerant landscaping in the four quadrants of the interchange.

Your Patience is Appreciated: Sacramento County understand the challenges and inconvenience that commuters, residents, businesses, bicyclists and pedestrians will experience during the closure period. The patience and cooperation of the traveling public is appreciated as work to construct the interchange project continues.
